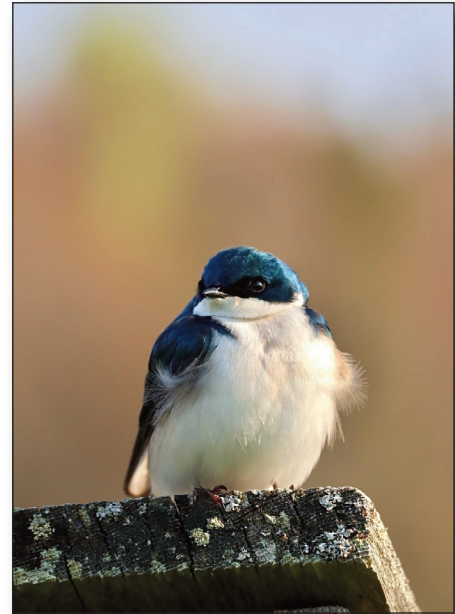

"I always feel at peace when I walk around my property, listening to the birds and watching small critters run across the trails. It's what makes me truly happy."

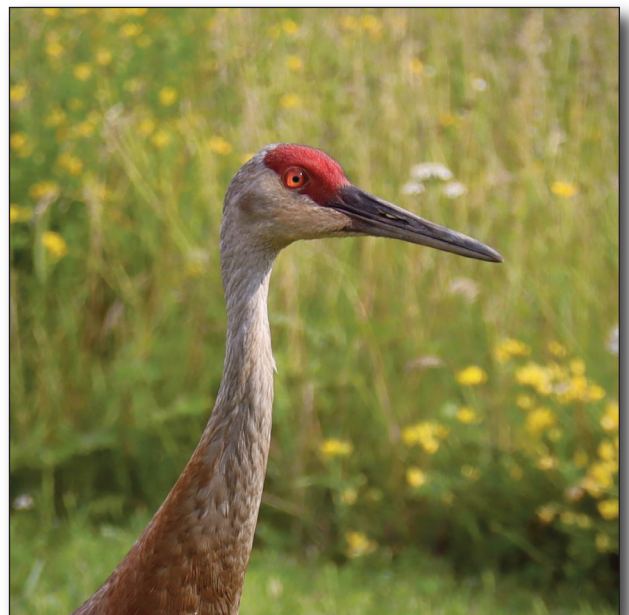
