For me, the years I have put into my artwork are ongoing learning sessions and every piece I create I learn something new.

Other than attending a few art classes in high school and one college level course, I am self-taught. I have learned so much by reading, studying the old masters, teaching and by not being afraid to experiment with materials and images. As I continue to learn new ways to manipulate mediums, I grow as an artisan and reduce the chance of stagnation.


